| <p>Throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, the risk of child exploitation has never been greater with children not in school, changes to their routine, increased stress and isolation.</p> <p>During this one-hour virtual session you will learn: What Safe and Sound does, What is Child Exploitation, The grooming process, Spotting the signs of exploitation, Who may be most at risk of child exploitation and How Safe and Sound support children and young people.</p> <p>Any child, regardless of their age, sex, family background or culture can be the victim of exploitation. By raising awareness of child exploitation, and adjusting potentially harmful behaviours at an early stage, we can prevent exploitation ever happening - avoiding a devastating experience for the child and their family.</p> | | | |




DERBY DIRECTION WEBSITE




- 01 Choose a topic heading from the main menu below to access the relevant services.
